# Pentomino Cards 

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## INTRODUCTION

The pentomino is a shape made of five congruent squares joined edge-to-edge (see chart in back of book).

The student will need a complete set of pentominoes (12 pieces each) to create the designs featured on these 48 cards.

The cards are grouped in four increasingly difficult skill levels: Set A, Beginner's Set; Set B, Stairs; Set C, Rectangles; Set D, Expert's Set.

As students become competent in solving these puzzles, they will enjoy experimenting to create their own designs. Encourage them to record their solutions and to share the challenges with their classmates.

## ADDITIONAL SUGGESTIONS

- Use the pentominoes to make more creatures like the person on Al or the giraffe on A2. Make more faces like Al2 and Al3, or symmetric designs like A14.
- Puzzles A3 through All are pentomino "blow-ups," which are twice the dimensions of a regular pentomino. Can you make "blow-ups" that are three times the dimensions?
- Make pentomino stairs larger than the ones in Set B. Can you make rectangles larger than the ones in Set C?
- Puzzles D5 and D6 will have "holes" in it when all the pentominoes have been put into place. Can you solve this puzzle with the holes placed in symmetric positions? with the holes all together?
